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Location

The is prominently situated on Durham Road within a short parade which is set back into a pedestrianised area and still highly visible from the main road. Low Fell is a busy and highly populated suburb of Gateshead and is approximately 1.5 miles from Gateshead centre and 2 miles from Newcastle city centre. The Angel of the north and the entrance to the A1 is approximately 2 miles away. There is a high level of passing trade in this area and free parking on the surrounding streets as well as in a large car park.
